HOUSEHOLD & DEPENDANT POLICY

REQUIREMENTS:

To qualify for the discounted Junior and Youth rates when purchasing (2) Adult Unlimited passes, you must meet the below definition of a household AND you will be required to show proof* of dependency annually, due to guests adding individuals to their orders whom are NOT household members. This proof is required even if you've purchased a Junior/Youth pass at discounted rates before. Please be prepared to show this proof when picking up a season pass or email us the proof before any of the household members pick up their pass. We reserve the right to not issue and/or charge the correct amount before any of the passes are issued.

DEFINITION OF A HOUSEHOLD:

- Two legally married adults with dependent children all living in the same household.
- If family members have different last names, then proof of a birth certificate for dependents is required.
- If married and filing taxes individually, then the address on tax information must match and dependents must be listed on either form.
- Relatives who live together do not qualify. For example, two brothers living together with their children.
- Grandparents, in-laws, nannies, groundskeepers, housekeepers, roommates, etc., do not qualify.
- January 1, 2020 is the birthday cut-off date for the 2019-20 season. How old is the individual on January 1, 2020?

*Proof of household /dependency could include: 1) most recent tax return documentation, 2) birth certificates for minors (18 & under), 3) health insurance where dependent is listed as covered, 4) court approved adoption papers (with signature or seal), 5) court approved foster children living at residence, 6) marriage certificate for blended families, 7) legal guardianship documentation.
